Inauguration cum demonstration of community drier at Locur, Dharwad

NRCS and UAS Dharwad jointly organized the Inauguration cum- demonstration of community drier at Locur village of Dharwad district on 15 December 05. About 300 farmers attended this programme. Dr. Nadgoud, Director of Extension,

UAS, Dharwad in his inaugural speech suggested "Gram panchayat" to take over the demonstration of the technology of harvesting at physiological maturity and artificial drying to the farmers to prevent mold aided grain deterioration in kharif due to rains around maturity and harvest. The advantages of the technology of harvesting at physiological maturity using artificial drier were explained to the farmers by the local innovative farmer who is familiar with it . He explained that by following the technology not only the kharif sorghum becomes remunerative but also the land is vacated 10-15 days earlier for sowing of a second crop. Farmers were impressed by the community dryer and were inquisitive about drying of other crops with it. The event was coordinated by Dr. Kamatar, Senior Scientist, UAS, Dharwad and S. Seed - day at NRCS

All scientists of NRCS actively participated in the seed-day and demonstration of shootfly nursery at Arboretum farms of NRCS on 21 December 2005. The seed day was organized at the breeder seed plot of CS 3541 at NRCS by Dr. N Kannababu. The scientific fraternity of various disciplines participated in the

seed day and discussed on the issues of sorghum seed quality maintenance and distribution system. In the shootfly nursery the promising lines of pre-breeding material of elite x shoot fly resistant sources, 6 RILs of 296 B X IS 18551 and three new germplasm lines were observed by the team.

BSP monitoring team visits NRCS

Institute's quarterly Scientific Research Council Meeting

Three scientists presented the progress and achievements of various projects during the SRC on 9 December 05. Dr. CV Ratnavathi presented the progress of the ICAR network project "Prevention and management of mycatoxins contamination in sorghum". The progress in the APNL biotechnology project "Enhancing tolerance of sorghum to aboitic stresses through genetic manipulation" was presented by Dr. SV Rao. The team of scientists also discussed the revised proposal of the APNL biotechnology project submitted by Dr. KBRS Visarada on "Evalving transgenic sorghum with suitable Bt gene constructs resistant to stem-borer". The director outlined the future hybrid research programme which had been earlier approved by the ICAR review committee headed by the DDG (CS).

Institute Biosafety Committee (IBSC) meeting

The Institute Biosafety Committee (IBSC) met on 30 December 2005 under the Chairmanship of Director, NRCS. The DBT-Naminee, Dr. V Dashawanth Reddy, Head, CPMB, Osmania
