Welcome to New Year 2024

Training on Millets and allied farming

A two-day training programme entitled “Millets and allied farming” was organized for farmers during 25-26 January 2024 at ICAR-Indian Institute of Millets Research, Hyderabad under the ICAR - Farmer FIRST Project (FFP). A total of 55 farmers participated in the training programme, from Chalki, Rukmapur, Mungi and Murthujapur villages of Sangareddy district of Telangana state.

On the inaugural day, Dr. Rajendra R. Chapke, PS & PI FFP briefed the trainees about the purpose and importance of the programme. At the outset, Dr. KBRS Visarada, PS & Director in-charge, IIMR welcomed the participants and encouraged farmers to go beyond millet cultivation and to focus on millet processing, marketing and value-addition also.



An overview on latest millet production and processing technologies was given by Dr. Swarna Ronanki, Scientist & Co-PI, FFP (Agronomy). In an interactive session with farmers the IIMR scientists - Drs. Aruna, PS (Plant Breeding), KN Ganapathy, PS (Plant Breeding), N. Anuradha, Scientist & Co-PI, FFP (Agrl. Economics) and A. Srinivas, Scientist & Co-PI, FFP (Agrl. Extension) participated and clarified the doubts.

Later, farmers visited the Centre of Excellence, Nutrihub, millet processing facilities and live demonstration plots at IIMR for exposure on improved production and processing technologies. As a part of the programme, they also visited AICRP-IFS, PJTSAU, to get latest information on integrated farming system (IFS) and ICAR- Directorate of Poultry Research, to understand in details about rural poultry farming and its improved management practices. The participants were more interested to know importance of millets and its nutritional benefits especially marketing of value-added products as well as their farm produce. In general, Farmers expressed their satisfaction and were keen to use improved technologies to enhance their returns. 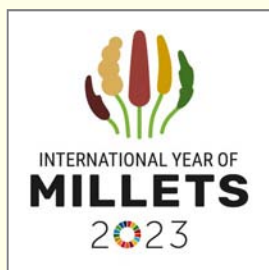
