## **Technical excursion of Agricultural Ministers of G20 nations**

As part of the 3-day G20 meeting of Agricultural Ministers at Hyderabad, a technical excursion of Agricultural Ministers of G20 countries was held at ICAR-Indian Institute of Millets Research, Hyderabad on 17 June, 2023.

A traditional welcome was given to G20 Agricultural Ministers and delegates by folk dancers of millet growing states of Maharashtra, Rajasthan, and Madhya Pradesh was done initially. Su shri Shobha Karandlaje, Honorable Minister of State of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare - welcomed all the G20 Agricultural Ministers with a traditional Stole and Mala.



The excursion included visit to demonstration plots of all the nine millet crops and were briefed on the various growth stages of millets by Dr. C Tara Satyavathi, Director, ICAR-IIMR. Planting of millet crops was taken up by agricultural ministers. The Ministers also visited the primary and secondary millet processing facilities, bakery unit, flaking unit, packing units, Centre of Excellence Nutrihub, TBI-where they tasted traditional millet recipes, millet version of popular recipes G20 nations.

An exhibition showcasing the strength of ICAR - Indian Institute of Millets Research as Global Centre of Excellence on R&D on Millets, millet entrepreneurs and millet science was inaugurated by Honorable Minister Su Shri Shobha Karandlaje along with the G20 Agricultural Ministers. The millet entrepreneurs displayed their diverse food products. Two books entitled "International Millet Recipes" and "Milletology" were released by all the Honourable Agricultural Ministers of G20 nations. A film on history of millets and a film on importance of millets showcasing climate resilience, nutritional superiority, and role of IIMR in research, value addition, entrepreneurship development and

## Millets Genetic Stocks Recommended for Registration

ICAR-National Bureau of Plant Genetic Resources (NBPGR) organized 50<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Plant Germplasm Registration Committee virtually under the Chairmanship of Dr. Tilak Raj Sharma, DDG (Crop Science), ICAR on 12 June, 2023. Twelve out of 14 millets genetic stocks proposed by IIMR-Hyderabad were considered by the PGRC and recommended for registration. The recommended millets genetic stocks include 6 Finger millet for the traits of earliness, blast resistance, banded leaf blight

resistance, non-lodging, more number of fingers and long fingers; and 6 Sorghum for the traits of longer leaf, brown midrib, green and dry fodder productivity, hurda, early flowering and maturing, high iron and zinc. Dr. C. Tara Satyavathi, Director, ICAR-IIMR-Hyderabad clarified the Chairman on the trait importance of the proposed millets genetic stocks during the discussion. Drs. M Elangovan and B. Amasiddha along with other developers of the genetic stocks from ICAR-IIMR and AICRP on Sorghum and Small millets participated in the meeting.
