The Chairman and Members gave valuable suggestions for the improvement of various projects and stressed on the increased efforts and collaborations due to the greater responsibility of the Institute as Global Centre of Excellence on Millets. The proceedings of the meeting are being finalized for the approval of the committee and further submission to the council.

International training workshop on "ISTA: Seed Quality Assurance"

An international training workshop on "ISTA: Seed Quality Assurance" was organized by ICAR-IIMR, under the aegis of Indo-German Bilateral Cooperation on Seed Sector Development at Telangana International Seed Testing Authority (TISTA), TSSOCA, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad, Telangana during 15-19 October, 2023. This workshop was aimed at providing

knowledge on the quality management system for the seed testing laboratories and dealt with important topics of seed



quality assurance as per ISTA standards, ISTA accreditation, technical and practical aspects of advances in seed moisture, germination and purity testing. International experts from ISTA were the resource persons for the workshop. included Dr. Florina Palada, ISTA Head of Accreditation and Technical Department, Dr. Joël Léchappé, ISTA Honorary Life Member, Mr. Craig McGill, ISTA ECOM Member & former ISTA President, Dr. G.V Jagadish, Member, ISTA TCOM Vigour and Storage Committee and Technical Advisor (QA), Dr. Malavika Dadlani, Former Joint Director (Research), ICAR-IARI, New Delhi and Dr. Keshavulu Kunusoth, ISTA-President, Director - TSSOCA & TISTA, Hyderabad. A total of 25 participants, drawn across different parts of the country including private and public sector participated in the training. In the inaugural session, Dr. K Keshavulu, President ISTA, Switzerland emphasized the importance of seed testing and quality assurance. Dr. C Tara Satyavathi Director, ICAR-IIMR, Hyderabad highlighted the role of Seed Testing Laboratories in India in quality seed supply and seed export.
