Laying Foundation Stone for Staff Quarters

Sorghum (NRCS), Solapur was laid by Dr. Mangala Rai, Director General, ICAR, New Delhi in the presence of Dr. G. Kalloo, DDG (CS&H), ICAR on 25 September 2005. Dr. DG Dhandhar, Director, CIAH, Bikaner; Dr. Ramchandra, OSD, NRC for Pomegranate; Dr. AL Pharande, ADR & Chief Scientist (Soils), MPKV, Solapur and Shri Chinchghare, Executive Engineer, CPWD, Nasik also graced the occasion. A total of 10 staff quarters (Type IV-2, Type III-4 and Type II-4) are being built within a year at a cost of 72.23 lakhs.

On 25 September, Dr. Mangala Rai, DG, ICAR and Dr. G. Kalloo, DDG (CS & H) visited our rabi centre at Solapur after the foundation-stone laying ceremony for the NRC for Pomegranate at Solapur. 




