Foundation Stone for Regional Research Station for Pearl Millet at Barmer, Rajasthan

A momentous occasion in the history of ICAR-Indian Institute of Millets Research, Hyderabad has taken place as the foundation stone for the Regional Research station for Pearl millet in Gudamalani, Barmer, on 27 September, 2023. This



significant project, is enhance aimed agricultural research and development in Barmer-Jaisalmer area of Raiasthan. Honorable Vice President of India Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar, laid the foundation stone for this research center in the presence of Shri. Narendra Singh Tomar (online), Hon'ble. Minister of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare, Shri Kailash Choudhary, Hon'ble. Minister of State Agriculture Farmers' Welfare, Arjun Ram Meghwal ji, of Minister (Independent Charge), Shri Devji M. Hon'ble Member Parliament, Lok Sabha, Shri Hemram Choudhary, Deputy Director General, Bhartiya Shri Sansthan, Anusandhan Himanshu Pathak, Secretary (DARE) Director General (ICAR), and Dr. (Mrs) C. Tara Satyavathi, Director, ICAR-Indian Institute of Millets Research other dignitaries.

Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar, Hon'ble Vice President of India said that food production through profitable farming is a challenge for the farmers of the arid regions and this is most amplified in the low rainfall regions of Rajasthan where kharif season in characterized by scanty rainfall and high day temperature. Crops such as Pearl millet come to the rescue of farmers in such situations which need less water and can tolerate high temperatures. He also stated that this is a milestone event happening in the history of dryland agriculture of far-reaching consequences for the farming community with the laying of foundation stone for a dedicated research station for Pearl millet and other "shree anna" millets in the heart of arid region of the country.

Shri. Narendra Singh Tomar, Hon'ble. Minister of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare said that for North-Western states of Rajasthan, Haryana and Gujarat, Pearl mille is an integral part of the farming and diet. Now, recognizing the prime importance of Pearl mille that has maximum area and production among millet crops, the leading state in Pearl millet production has been chosen to host the Pearl millet research station under the Shree Anna research institute. This is one of the initiatives of the government to reach out to the well-being of small and marginal farmers in the dry regions of the country and

the efforts towards ensuring food and nutritional security.

Shri Kailash Choudhary, Hon'ble. Minister of State for Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare expressed that the establishment of a dedicated research centre for Pearl millet, the main food crop of the dry zone of Rajasthan had been the cherished dream for decades which is now becoming a reality. He also hoped that the research efforts of the centre located in the region itself will ensure development and dissemination of technologies appropriate for the region, in participation with farmers and the way suitable for the farming community and consumption as well.

Dr. Himanshu Pathak, Secretary (DARE) & Director General (ICAR) opined that this initiative aligns with the government's broader mission to boost millet productivity, improve crop resilience, and empower farmers with innovative techniques and technologies.

Dr. (Mrs) C. Tara Satyavathi, Director, ICAR-IIMR-Hyderabad stated that the Pearl millet Regional Research station in Gudamalani is committed to play a pivotal role in advancing research related to bajra (pearl millet) cultivation, which is a staple crop in the region.

This programme was conducted in association with KVK, Gudamalani, CSWRI, Avikanagar, CAZRI, Jodhpur, AICRP-Pearl millet, Jodhpur, and state departments. Drs. 21-day Refresher Course on Shree Anna 2023

ICAR-Indian Institute of Millets Research, Hyderabad has successfully conducted a 21-days Online Refresher Course on "Millets (Shree Anna) as Model Crops for Sustainable Farming, Value Addition, Entrepreneurship Development and Nutritional Security" from 07 to 27 September, 2023. This course was designed for scientists of ICAR, SMS of KVKs, Research Scholars, Students, Entrepreneurs, Agriculture Officers, and members of FPOs working on the improvement, production, and popularization of millets. The refresher course served as a platform to link Students-Researchers-Entrepreneurs working on various dimensions of millet crops.

The inaugural programme was held on 07 September, 2023, and opening remarks about the course was presented by Dr. KBRS Visarada, Director In-charge, ICAR-IIMR, Hyderabad.
